

Navy Training incorporates CPS

Naval Computer and Telecommunications Area Master Station Atlantic (NCTAMS LANT) is incorporating cutting edge instructional technology into IT training for over 280 enlisted and officer personnel.

The Classroom Performance System (CPS) is an infrared PC-based tool that provides real-time interaction during lectures with automated performance tracking and trend analysis. The system is in use in many top corporations and throughout academia.

NCTAMS LANT's successful implementation of CPS has recently drawn attention from other communities and will soon be demonstrated to the Center for Leadership Excellence for possible inclusion in their training program.

NCTAMS LANT conducts the training weekly for the enlisted ITs and IP officers that make up the command's Operations Department.

In addition, the command has demonstrated the CPS training tool to other local commands, and the system is already in use throughout the submarine force, both afloat and ashore.
